

10+3 principles in school space design

1. School is a Learning Center connected with the neighborhood
2. School offers spaces for interaction and communication with the cultural and social life of the city
3. School space, indoor and outdoor, incorporates a variety that serves both educational process, and child's centers of interest.
4. The organization of school space takes into account the educational coexistence forms in the classroom
5. School space is flexible enough to facilitate the application of different teaching techniques with different requirements for the arrangement of furniture and equipment
6. Flexible classroom incorporates the teaching potential given by Information and Communication Technology (ICT)
7. The house constitutes an aesthetic standard for school space
8. A pupil as well as a group of pupils has the opportunity to appropriate school space and to create their own place (lieu)
9. There are "intermediate" spaces with educational significance, connecting the inner and outdoor school space.
10. School space contributes to the pupil's rising of environmental awareness.

And definitely,

1. School space designing takes into account the scale and the developmental needs of the child
2. School space designing takes into account child's imagination world, especially in kindergarten
3. *Besides issues concerning the function of school building, the designer of school space should definitely incorporate into his study everything that the children and teachers see, do, and live while they use the space.*
